## **PASADENA ARTS COUNCIL RECEIVES \$22,000 IN FUNDING FROM THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS TO SUPPORT “SKIN/ART & IDEAS 2007 FESTIVAL”**

The Pasadena Arts Council was pleased to announce it has received its first grant from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) to support the upcoming citywide arts festival, “Skin/Art & Ideas 2007”. The \$22,000 grant will support the Arts Council’s presentation of a Public Conversation Series as part of the festival. Skin/Art & Ideas 2007 taking place from October 10 through 31, 2007 at 16 different venues throughout Pasadena. Skin/Art & Ideas involves the participation of 22 Pasadena art, cultural, and scientific institutions and community organizations.

Of the 951 grants awarded nationwide in this second and final round of NEA funding for 2007, the Pasadena Arts Council was one of 15 local arts agencies and three in California and the only local arts agency in Los Angeles to receive funding. 53 grants were awarded to arts organizations in the Los Angeles area. The Pasadena Arts Council joins the Pasadena Playhouse and the Pacific Asia Museum as NEA recipients. The Pasadena Art Council’s grant was the second largest, following the Pasadena Playhouse grant of \$30,000 and ahead of the Pacific Asia Museum’s \$10,000 grant. The awards granted to the Los Angeles region total \$1,422,000.

The National Endowment for the Arts grants total \$67,348,450, and will benefit local, state, regional, and national arts organizations across the country in the categories of Access to Artistic Excellence, Arts on Radio and Television, Learning in the Arts, Partnerships, and American Masterpieces.

"The National Endowment for the Arts is committed to bringing the best of the American arts to all Americans. Our grants range from supporting new presentations of theatrical classics and contemporary art to providing arts workshops in schools—across all fifty states in communities large and small. I am delighted to announce this most recent round of NEA support," said NEA Chairman Dana Gioia.

Access to Artistic Excellence grants awarded in this round support the creation and presentation of work in the disciplines of dance, design, folk and traditional arts, literature, media arts, museums, music, musical theater, presenting, theater, and visual arts. These grants include commissions, residencies, workshops, performances, exhibitions, publications, festivals, and professional development programs. The NEA funded 620 grants in this category out of 1,040 eligible applications, for a total federal investment of \$12,510,250.
